## NAS Quick Restore DVD

This Quick Restore DVD restores the NAS device to its factory default state. The process outlined on this Quick Restore DVD restores your NAS device and reconfigures the internal operating system drives to their factory defaults.

 **CAUTION:** Read all material contained within this document before beginning. The NAS Quick Restore **will erase all data** on the system drives. Refer to the *HP StorageWorks NAS Administration Guide* and the *HP StorageWorks NAS Installation Guide* for information on backing up data prior to performing a Quick Restore procedure.


 **CAUTION:** This Quick Restore DVD is intended for use only with the NAS device and should not be used with any other platform.

## Requirements

The NAS Quick Restore DVD requires that the console be attached either through the Integrated Lights Out port or a directly attached keyboard, monitor, and mouse.

## Quick Restore Procedure

1. Connect the console of the NAS device directly to an attached keyboard, monitor, and mouse or the ILO port.
2. Insert the Quick Restore DVD.
3. Reboot the NAS device.
4. After the Quick Restore DVD has booted, select **E** for English or **J** for Japanese.
5. Verify that you want to continue with the Quick Restore process by pressing **Q** to continue or **E** to exit without restoring the image.

 **CAUTION:** Once the restore has begun do not interrupt the restore process.

6. When all information has been restored from the DVD, the device automatically ejects the DVD and reboots. Remove the DVD and store it in a secure location.

**NOTE:** This Quick Restore DVD is intended for DVD drives that have a manually loading tray. If your DVD drive has an automatic tray, ensure that the DVD is removed when it is ejected.

Follow the procedures in the installation guide to complete configuration of the NAS device.
