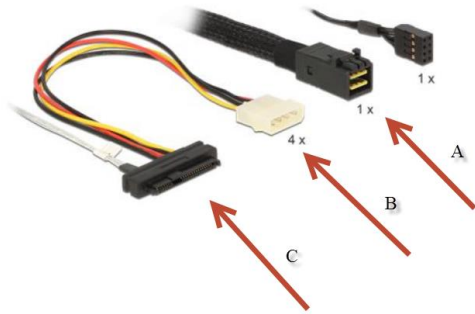

Connecting the cable (LTO-7, LTO-6, and LTO-5)

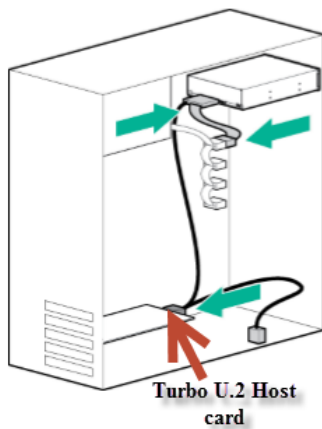
If you are installing the tape drive in an enclosure using the cable that came with the enclosure, skip this section and follow the instructions included with the enclosure to cable the drive.

To connect the cable that came with the tape drive to a server or enclosure:

1. Connect the combined SAS and power connector to the tape drive port.
2. Connect the SAS connector without the cover to the host port, which could be on an HBA or on the controller board.

Leave the cover on the unused SAS connector.

3. Plug the power connector into the power supply cabling.



Although there is power on the HP6250 LTO-6 Ultrium, whatever settings I use in the Bios for the M.2 port, the tape drive is not found in either the BIOS or Windows 10.
